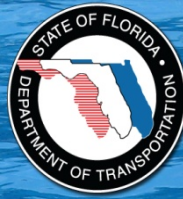

Little Blue Heron Bridge Construction To Begin December 2009

The **Little Blue Heron Bridge**, located in the City of Riviera Beach, is currently scheduled to undergo a complete bridge replacement beginning this December 2009. This 0.19-mile bridge spans the Lake Worth Lagoon, connecting AIA from Phil Foster Park to Singer Island.

Construction is being performed by The Murphy Construction Company, and is expected to last approximately 18 months. The project includes removing the existing low-level, fixed bridge and replacing it with a new four-lane fixed bridge in the same location. In conjunction with this project, the **Little Lake Worth Bridge** that connects Singer Island to US 1 and PGA Blvd. will undergo construction and replacement in Spring 2010. The combined cost for these projects is estimated at \$10.1 million.

In an effort to minimize the impact on the motoring public, the bridge will remain open to traffic during construction. Traffic will be reduced from two lanes to one lane in each direction, with access to parks and local businesses maintained throughout the project. To ensure the safety of pedestrians and park patrons, fishing and diving in the vicinity of the bridge will not be permitted during construction.

We appreciate your patience and understanding regarding the bridge replacement. The exact project start date will be advertised on lighted message boards along the roadway near the bridge and via the project web-site, www.pbfdot.com, once confirmed.
